Claudia Kunschak (Ph.D. Education, University of Arizona; M.A. Interpreting, University of Vienna) is a professor of English at the College of International Relations at Ritsumeikan University (Kyoto, Japan). She has worked in Austria, China, Scotland, Spain, Ukraine, and the United States. Her research interests include language awareness, critical pedagogy, and translingual/transcultural competence.



Dr. Bruna Sommer-Farias is an Assistant Professor in the Master of Arts in Foreign Language Teaching at Michigan State University. She completed her PhD in SLAT at the University of Arizona in 2020, and currently teaches in-service teachers on topics such as multiliteracies, genre and corpus-based pedagogies, multilingualism, and intercultural competence.



Dr. Stefano Maranzana is an Italian and French lecturer at Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas. He holds a Ph.D. in Second Language Acquisition and Teaching from the University of Arizona, and researches the use of animated cartoons with same-language captions and virtual reality for second language acquisition.
